Plans after graduation

According to the Undergraduate Senior Exit Survey Report (2017-2018), 74.1% of respondents indicated their immediate post-graduation plan to be employed full-time or part-time immediately after graduation, while 22.3% plan to attend graduate or professional school fulltime or part-time. The remaining respondents (3.6%) indicated an intention to either pursue additional coursework, military service, start or raise a family, or volunteer.
