Office of Teacher Clinical Experiences

All teacher candidates enrolled in the undergraduate teacher preparation program will be required to complete a year-long teacher intern residency (Phase I and Phase II). All teacher candidates enrolled in the Certification-Only Program will be required to complete either a teacher intern residency (Phase I and Phase II) or an academic internship under the direct supervision of the Office of Teacher Clinical Experiences.
