

POLICIES:

Excuses for class: SHS will provide excuses only for students who have missed class while being seen in our clinic. Any extended excuse will be given at the discretion of the practitioner. Excuses given for a prolonged period of time will automatically be reported to the Dean of Students.

Chronic medical problems: Students with chronic unstable medical illnesses are to be under the care of their personal physician. SHS will work in collaboration with the student's physician to assist with blood work, blood pressure monitoring, allergy injections, nebulizer treatments, and/or any other related procedures while they are attending UL Lafayette.

The decision about whether a student may be seen for a chronic medical condition at SHS will be based on safety and best medical practices, taking into account the student's resources and preference for care. We reserve the right to refer a student to an off-campus provider if in our clinician's opinion the referral is in the student's best interest.

GENERAL INFORMATION:

The UL Lafayette Student Health Services (SHS) strives to provide quality, accessible, cost sensitive, primary medical care and active health promotion to the students within the campus community.

The SHS follows the University hours of operations throughout the year. There is a general staff meeting every Tuesday morning and a clinicians' meeting every Thursday morning.

SHS operates by appointment only, but same day work-in appointments are available. To minimize your wait time, please call before coming in. Patients are triaged by a nurse prior to being seen by a clinician. Allow time for completing and/or updating personal data each semester. If you have any insurance coverage, please bring your proof of insurance coverage to each visit.

In case of an emergency when the clinic is closed, please contact the University Police (482-6447) or seek care at a local emergency room.

CLINIC SERVICES:

Eligibility: All students who are taking six (6) or more class hours in the fall/spring and three (3) or more hours in the summer have been assessed a membership through the student fees at registration. Any currently enrolled student not meeting these hourly requirements may purchase a membership for the current fee.

Membership includes office visits for acute illnesses, minor injuries, general physicals, and management of chronic stable medical illnesses.

Billable services may include laboratory tests (ex: blood work, pap smears), office procedures (ex: laceration repair, mole removal, ingrown toenail procedures, wart treatment, and ear irrigations), and any injections administered or medications dispensed in our office.

Services not offered include dental care, obstetrical care, and care of injuries sustained as a result of an auto accident or work related accident. SHS personnel can assist with specialist referrals when needed. X-ray services are not available on-site, but when necessary, are available through several outpatient radiology facilities in the area.

INSURANCE:

DOMESTIC STUDENTS:

Accident Only Policy: During the academic year, undergraduate students who are enrolled in at least 7 hours in the fall or spring or 4 hours in the summer and graduate students who are enrolled in 6 hours in the fall or spring or 3 hours in the summer will have an Accident-Only Policy. The fee will be assessed in your registration fees. For more information, see our website.
