## Graduate Assistant - Living Learning Communities

The Graduate Assistant (GA) for Living Learning Communities works directly with the Office of First Year Experience as well as the Office of Residential Life in the planning, delivery, and execution of living learning community programming and academic retention. The Graduate Assistant reports directly to the Associate Director of First Year Experience and indirectly to the Rose Garden Area Coordinator.
