The relevant University policy at issue is the University Policy on Prohibited Sexual Conduct, Sexual Assault, which provides in relevant part:

II. Purpose of Policy

The University is committed to creating and maintaining a campus environment in which all individuals are treated with respect and dignity and are free to participate in a lively exchange of ideas. Furthermore, the University is committed to fostering an environment in which all members of our campus community are safe, secure, and free from Sexual Misconduct of any form, including but not limited to Sexual Assault, Dating Violence, Domestic Violence, and Stalking. The University expects that all interpersonal relationships and interactions – especially those of an intimate nature – he grounded upon mutual respect, open communication, and clear Consent. Each student has the right to learn and each employee has the right to work in an environment free of Prohibited Sexual Conduct.

The purpose of this Policy is also to ensure that no member of the University community will be retaliated against for refusing or objecting to Prohibited Sexual Conduct, or making an allegation related to Prohibited Sexual Conduct.

1. Prohibited Sexual Conduct includes:

a. Sexual Misconduct

This Policy prohibits Sexual Misconduct as well as any attempt to commit Sexual Misconduct.

IV. Definitions

Sexual Misconduct: is a sexual act or contact of a sexual nature that occurs, regardless of personal relationship, without the Consent of the other person(s), or that occurs when the person(s) is unable to give Consent or whose Consent is coerced or obtained in a fraudulent manner. For the purpose of this Policy, Sexual Misconduct includes, but is not limited to, Sexual Assault, Sexual Abuse, violence of a sexual nature. Sexual Harassment, non-Consensual sexual intercourse, Sexual Exploitation, video voyeurism, contact of a sexual nature with an object, or the obtaining, posting or disclosure of intimate descriptions, photos, or videos without the express Consent [of] the persons depicted therein, as well as Dating Violence. Domestic Violence, and Stalking.

Sexual Assault: is:

a. Sexual Assault as defined by the Clery Act: an offense that meets the definition of rape, fondling, incest, or statutory rape as used in the FBI's UCR program. b. Sexual Assault as defined by Louisiana State Law:

ii. Non-Consensual Sexual Contactional sexual rouching, or attempted sexual rouching, without Consent

The parties have voluntarily agreed to a final, binding resolution with no investigative finding concerning complaint. This Voluntary Resolution is entered into knowingly and voluntarily in neu of a formal investigation and finding by both parties.

As a result of this Voluntary Resolution. grees to the following:

- 2. Should either party violate the terms of this Voluntary Resolution, it may be declared null and void and may result in additional enforcement actions by the University.

This Voluntary Resolution shall be effective on the date that a copy of the Voluntary Resolution setting forth his or her respective obligations and agreements has been signed by both parties.
