Bloodborne Pathogens

This course teaches the high-risk UL Lafayette employees about the communicable illnesses they can be exposed to on the job and how a pathogen enters the body. Proper procedures used to prevent the transmission of these diseases are covered as well as the use of hazard control kits and personal protective equipment. Hands on simulation is given to show participants how to properly administer personal protective equipment as well as how to utilize the decontamination kits for cleanup. High-risk employees are required to train annually on bloodborne pathogens. This is only offered as an instructor lead course and any employees who may come into contact with any body fluids are urged to take the course.

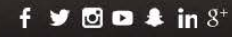
