Dear Dr. Wheelan,

I write to notify you of the University of Louisiana at Lafayette's intent to request authority to initiate a new program that constitutes a substantive change: a Master of Science in Kinesiology within the School of Kinesiology in the College of Education. The intended date of implementation is January 16, 2013. The University will submit a full Substantive Change Prospectus at least three months prior to initiation.

The College of education already offers numerous M.S. degrees including counselor education, and a Doctor of Education in Educational Leadership, as well as an M.Ed in Secondary Education which once offered a concentration in kinesiology but, following a College reorganization, no longer does. The program will build on the University's existing B.S. in Kinesiology program and faculty. The Master of Science degree in Kinesiology (KNES) focuses on professional preparation of candidates to develop, administer and implement broad-based programs in one of two concentrations: (1) Exercise and Sport Science or (2) Health Promotion, Recreation and Sport Management. The curriculum includes courses and guided electives offered for each concentration and will offer both online and traditional face-to-face instructional formats. This degree will build on existing programs in the Department of Kinesiology (i.e., Bachelor of Science Degree in Kinesiology with Concentrations in Health and Physical Education, Exercise Science, Health Promotion and Wellness, and Sports Management or the Bachelor of Science Degree in Athletic Training).

Again, a full substantive Change Prospectus will be forthcoming at least three months prior to implementation, together with documented approvals from the University of Louisiana System Board (already obtained) and the Louisiana Board of Regents (pending).
