Featuring over 35 research centers and institutes, UL-Lafayette generates over \$40 million in external funding each year and has earned the distinction as a Carnegie Research University with High Research Activity.

At a minimum, the candidate shall be expected to have an earned doctorate from an accredited institution and successful experience in an institution of higher education.
