- D. The corporation shall not make any investments in such manner as to subject it to tax under section 4944 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954, or corresponding provisions of any subsequent Federal tax laws.
- E. The corporation shall not make any taxable expenditures as defined in section 4945(d) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954, or corresponding provisions of any subsequent Federal tax laws.

This corporation will be at all times a subsidiary of the University of Louisiana at Lafayette Foundation ("The Foundation"), and its purpose is to support the activities of The Foundation and the University of Louisiana at Lafayette with regard to athletics.

### ARTICLE 3 DURATION

The corporation shall enjoy perpetual corporate existence unless sooner dissolved in accordance with law.
