During the 2016-2017 cycle, the master teacher for psychosocial content in the BSN program was changed. This instructor continues to deliver the didactic content of the course, and has integrated active learning strategies to increase learning and student engagement. In addition, the textbook utilized for this portion of NURS 340 was changed to reflect the most current nursing practice in this specialty area. The newly adopted textbook includes a plethora of online resources, and student feedback regarding this supplemental material has been positive.

Although the benchmark for achievement was not met during the 2017-2018 cycle, the strategies noted above have been implemented. The Curriculum and Program Evaluation Committees will continue to monitor student achievement of learning outcomes.

Although benchmarks have not yet been met in this area, Program Evaluation and Curriculum Committees will continue to monitor these results. Student performance in the clinical area, on teacher-made exams, and in the simulation setting will be monitored and appropriate pedagogical improvements will be instituted.
