One of our goals is to create new committee, while other goals involve direct student engagement. As a result we have several strategies to assess our different outcomes that range from pre/post test for student centered outcomes to benchmark assessment for office improvement outcomes.

What does the program/department expect to achieve with the goals and objectives identified above?

OFYE in general, and UNIV 100 in particular, are still very new programs given the history of the University. We are still 'finding out way' in terms of making the office and the program as efficient and effective as possible. We hope our goals will help us refine both the OFYE and UNIV 100 in profound, meaningful, and lasting ways.

How might prior or current initiatives (improvements) influence the anticipated outcomes this year?

This is year four of UNIV 100 in its current iteration. Each year builds on the previous version. Though they may operate in different ways, each version is based on lessons learned from previous years. And we use as much data as we can to 'learn' those lessons.

What is the plan for using data to improve student learning and/or operations?

We use pre/post to specifically target lessons in our classes. We are piloting a program where these specific lessons will be taught by OFYE staff rather than the ever changing faculty of UNIV 100 proper. We are hoping this will allow for more quality control in the lessons distribution and result in better outcomes as reflected in our data. But only time and data will tell.

How will data be shared within the Program/Department (and, where appropriate, the College/VP-area)?

Data is shared at bi-weekly staff meetings with the office and Executive Director. The Executive Director then shares appropriate data both up and down the organizational chart as she deems appropriate.
