In addition to maintaining internal records, our office is now responsible for entering all scholarships(except for Athletics scholarships) on student accounts in Banner and reconciling them across campus units throughout the semester. We are in the process of analyzing the numbers of transactions handled and how to best adapt to these changes. Data will be shared with our VP.
