Estimated Costs

The University offers a quality education at an affordable price. UL Lafayette is one of the nation's best institutions for undergraduate education, according to the 2017 edition of "The Best 381 Colleges" published by the *Princeton Review*.

The figures listed below are used for budgeting purposes and eligibility for need-based aid for the academic year. Your actual bill will differ from these estimates — they are provided for planning purposes only.

Tuition and fees and room and board for **on-campus housing** are the only costs that are paid directly to the University. Books, supplies, and other costs will vary for each student. The room & board figures for the commuter and off campus student are estimates of what costs a student could incur.
