Graduate Student Computer Lab

As a service to the University's graduate students, the library provides a graduate study room equipped with six computers. This room provides a quiet atmosphere for graduate students. The PCs offer the same programs that are available on the library STEP Computer Lab computers, including MS Office, Acrobat, Internet Explorer, Math Lab, and other applications. Students must log on with their University CLID and password. The computers are networked to one of the printers located in the STEP Computer Lab on the first floor. The print limit is 250 pages per semester.

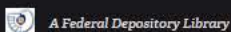
