Maintains active professional association and membership and appropriate licensure certification. Provides individual, marriage, family and group counseling; conducts psychosocial assessment; designs treatment plans and takes crises calls.
Qualifications:	Doctorate in a field related to services provided with appropriate licensure/certification. Record of successful leadership, clinical and administrative experience in appropriate field, preferable on a university campus in Student Affairs is ideal.
Administrative:	The University of Louisiana at Lafayette is a comprehensive, coeducational, public institution of higher education offering bachelors, masters, and doctoral degrees. Enrollment is approximately 16,700 students. The Counseling and Testing Center is one of 13 departments within the Student Affairs Division that is headed by the Vice President for Student Affairs.
