Distance Learning

Distance learning students and instructors are entitled to library services and resources equivalent to those offered on campus.

Services for **Distance Students** include:

- Reference and research assistance
- Remote access to all of the library's online holdings, including databases, journals, eBooks and reference collections
- **Article and book delivery** of materials not available in full text online
- Borrowing resources from other Louisiana institutions via the **LOUIS Reciprocal Borrowing Card**
- Borrowing journal articles from other libraries through our Interlibrary Loan service

Services for **Distance Instructors** include:

- Reference assistance and **library instruction**
- **Embedding a librarian** into your Moodle course
- Adding **library resources** to your Moodle course
- Requesting a subject or course specific research guide
