

Vice President for Research (VPR) Dr. Ramesh Kolluru oversees the research, economic development, and technology transfer activities of the University. He is charged with building alliances with local, regional, state, and national business, governmental, and industrial leaders that will result in funding, equipment, services, and other resources of the University. The VPR oversees the operation of some 40 research centers and institutes. He has held numerous positions at the University since beginning in 1996, including Assistant Vice President for Research, Director of the Center for Business Information and Technology, and as a tenured faculty member in computer science. Kolluru earned a bachelor's in mechanical engineering (1992) from Osmania University, a master's in computer science (1995), and Ph.D. in computer science (1996) from the University of Southwestern Louisiana.
