The University of Louisiana at Lafayette seeks a seasoned, innovative, and collaborative leader to assume the position of Dean of the College of Education. Reporting to the Provost and Vice President for Academic Affairs, the dean will be expected to begin service in 2016.

Founded in 1900, the University of Louisiana at Lafayette is the largest member of the University of Louisiana System with a current enrollment of over 19,000 students. Designated a Carnegie high research activity institution, the University of Louisiana at Lafayette offers degree programs at the baccalaureate through doctoral levels in the colleges of arts, education, engineering, liberal arts, nursing and allied health professions, along with the B.I. Moody III College of Business Administration, the Ray P. Authement College of the Sciences, University College, and the Graduate School.

The College of Education includes the following departments: Counselor Education, Curriculum and Instruction, Educational Foundations and Leadership, and the School of Kinesiology. The Dean of the College of Education will promote faculty development, lead enrollment management and program marketing, build and maintain positive and productive relationships among faculty and staff, encourage collaborative alliances within the area and state, and work collaboratively with other stakeholders to develop the potential of the Cecil J. Picard Center for Child Development and Lifelong Learning. Candidates with demonstrated accomplishments in innovative partnerships and policy development are preferred. The successful candidate will: have earned a terminal degree in a discipline appropriate to the College of Education; show evidence of accomplishments requisite for a senior faculty appointment in the college; possess a strong record of leadership as a faculty member, scholar, and administrator; have a deep knowledge of trends related to education, counselor education and kinesiology; and possess excellent interpersonal and communication skills.
