- I felt like there was too much emphasis on class material that wasn't related to the course adjectives. There was focus on things that she found interesting instead of material that would be on the exam.

That is the only complaint I have but that is a pretty big no-no to me. Aside from it however the class was good with a teacher that engages the students and is reachable.

- The pearson mastering course is great in theory but in practice it was done poorly. First it costing \$100 and being required was just a bad call for the school. Then what made it worst was that each question loses points based on on the number of attempts. The problem is it never mentions how many points you lost until after you completed the question. So if a question allowed 6 attempts and you tried 4 times it would never tell you how many points you lost if at all. Then the worst part was that it would frequently ask questions that are ether way too vague or has nothing to do with the course almost as if the teacher just assigned them based on the chapter and never actually looked at the question. Which seemed like the case as the last assignment had a question that physically couldn't be answered and if the teacher looked at the question they would have noticed it.
- The writing assignments are useful when thinking about applying what were learning about. the homework is a very useful study tool, it is easy to find the answers online because in my opinion you could not answer these just by attending lectures and sometimes not even after reading the book. However after you find the answers, studying the mastering homework assignments and understanding it is KEY.
