Analysis Questions and Analysis Answers

How were assessment results shared and evaluated within the unit?

Upon completion of the Annual Performance Report, a summary report is submitted to the Department of Education. Results of the report as they relate to the Upward Bound I program's mandatory objectives are shared with the Upward Bound staff, the Trio Directory, and the dean of University College.

Because of the enrichment classes and tutoring, the 2016 Bridge participants were better prepared for post secondary enrollment, received TOPS, and should complete the summer session with a higher gpa.

What has the unit learned from the current assessment cycle? What is working well, and what is working less well in achieving desired outcomes?

Based on the information received from the Bridge students, the program staff needs to provide more assistance with scholarship selection and completion. The UB staff will revise the scholarship packet and make it available to students through email and text. In addition, former Upward Bound students who received the Gates Millennium, Dell, and Glen Armentor scholarships will conduct a workshop for all UB seniors this fall (2016) to discuss how to complete scholarship applications and write winning scholarship essays.
