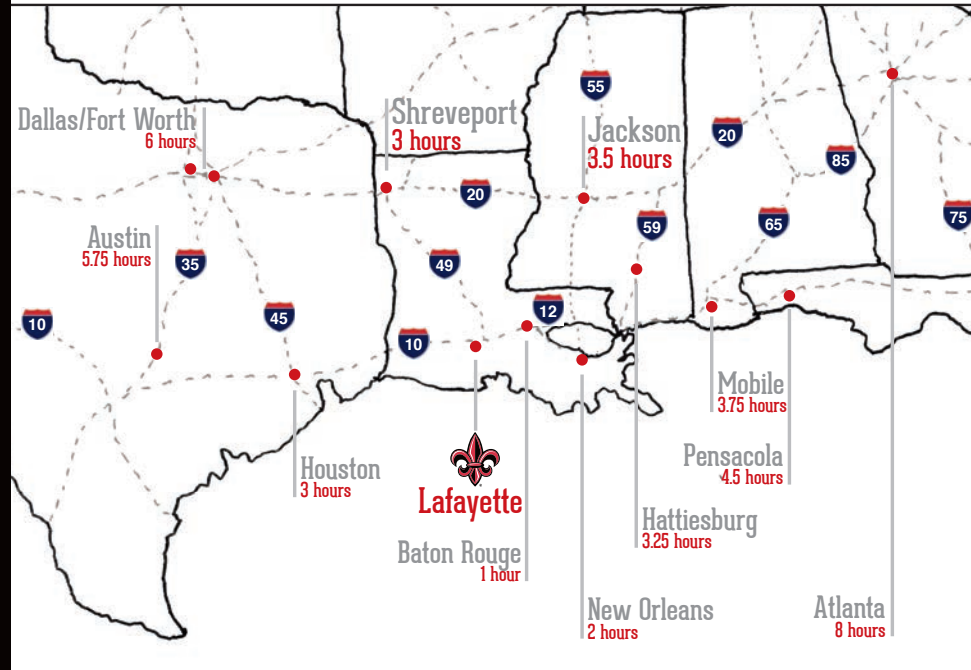

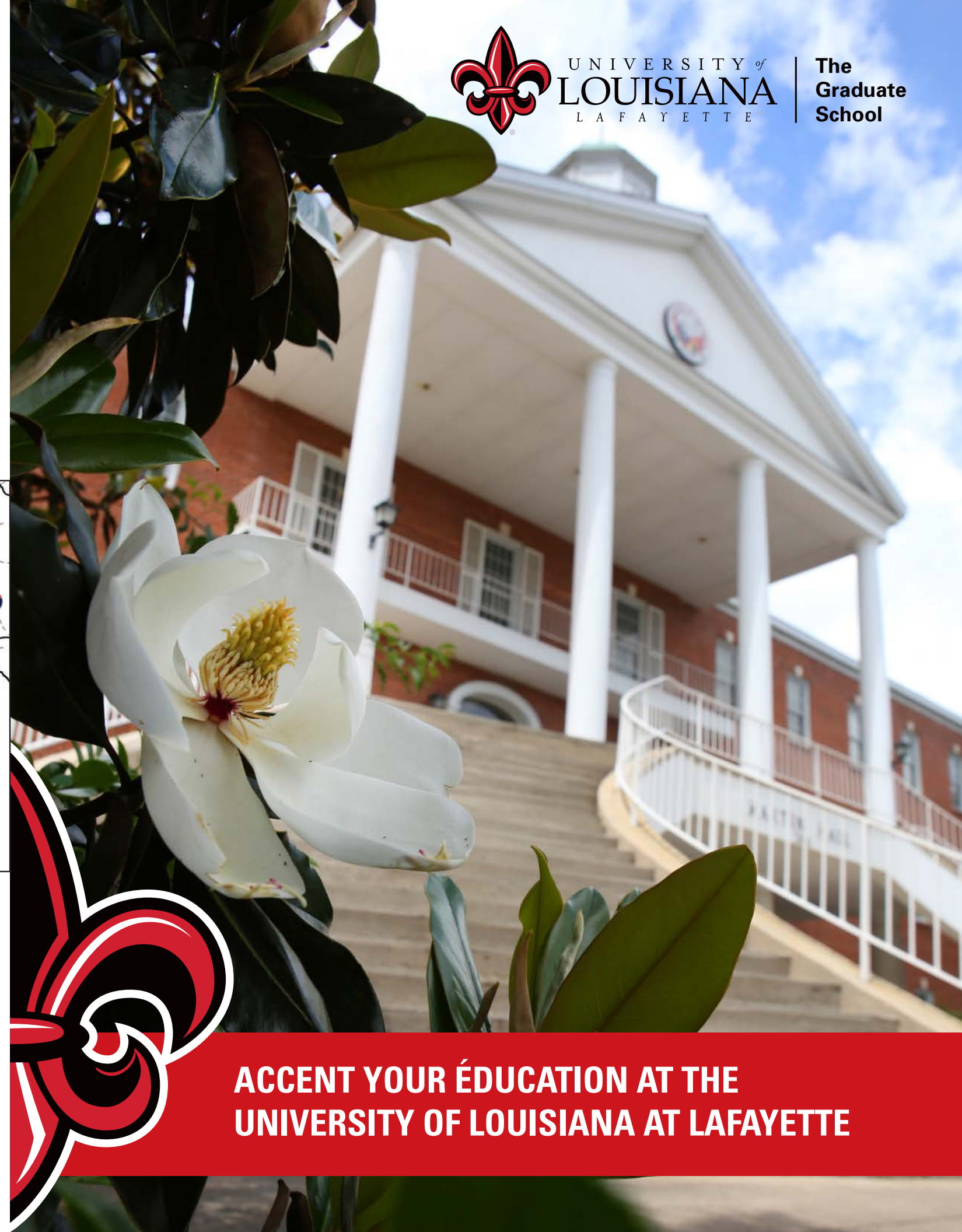

MONEY MATTERS

Graduate Assistantships & Fellowships

The Graduate School offers competitive funding opportunities through graduate teaching and research assistantships in addition to Master's and Doctoral fellowships. Many faculty and research centers also support graduate students through grant-funded research projects. Whether a fellowship, teaching assistantship, or research assistantship, these kinds of support provide both a tuition waiver and monthly living stipend, thus easing the financial commitment on your end and allowing you to focus on your graduate studies.

Teacher Tuition Incentive Program

An initiative of longtime President Ray P. Authement, the UL Lafayette Teacher Tuition Incentive Program assists currently-employed K-12 teachers and administrators as they pursue graduate studies by providing tuition grants of as much as \$1,000 per semester to support part-time enrollment.

McNair Master's Scholar Support

Each year, the Graduate School offers tuition and fee waivers to Master's students who have been participants of the Ronald E. McNair Scholars Program. Reach out to the Graduate School to learn about qualifications for this University support.

GSO and SGA Funding

Being successful in grad school means conducting and presenting research. The Graduate Student Organization and the Student Government Association at UL Lafayette both offer students funding to support research and travel.

Financial Aid

APPLYING TO UL LAFAYETTE

While some graduate programs accept applications on a rolling basis, others admit only once a year. We encourage you to submit all required application materials prior to any graduate-program-specific deadlines. After the deadline, late fees apply and we cannot guarantee that your application will be processed in time to start classes.

University Expectations for Graduate Admission

While the preferred GRE or GMAT scores below are an important part of the application, they are but one factor used to assess an applicant's potential for success at UL Lafayette.

Master's degree:

- 2.75 (4.0 scale) cumulative GPA or 3.0 in the last 60 hours of undergraduate study
- GRE – combined verbal and quantitative score of 287 with minimum verbal score of 145
- GMAT (Accounting and MBA only) – 450

Doctoral Degree:

- 3.0 (4.0 scale) cumulative GPA on all undergraduate work or 3.3 (4.0 scale) cumulative GPA on all graduate work
- GRE – combined verbal and quantitative score of 294 with minimum verbal score of 145

International Applicants:

- Copy of Valid Passport
- Proof of Financial Responsibility
- TOEFL/IELTS scores – total TOEFL score of 81 or total IELTS score of 6.5

All applicants must provide the following:

- Online Application
- Non-refundable Application Fee
- Official Transcripts
- Official GRE/GMAT Scores
- Three Letters of Reference
- Proof of Immunization

Application Deadlines:

Fall: June 30 | Spring: November 30 | Summer: April 30

University Fellowship Application Deadline: February 15

Master's and Doctoral University fellowships are awarded only in the Fall. To be considered for these select fellowships, all required application materials must be received by this date.

Graduate Assistantship Application Deadline:

Fall: March 1 | Spring: November 1

To be considered for assistantship funding, all required application materials must be received by these dates.
